3		<p>The first term of the academic year started on 20th June, 2020 in the background of the first wave of COVID-19 pandemic. The college work started by taking all the precautions regarding COVID-behaviour norms declared by the District administration and the U.G.C. from time to time. The duration of the first term was nine months. The term officially ended on 21st March, 2021. Following is a brief report of the activities completed in the first term of 2020-21.</p> <p>i) Department of English organised a one day International Webinar on 'Understanding Philosophy of Accreditation Framework' in association with IQAC of the college and Shivaji University, Kolhapur on 17th July, 2020. The HoD, Dr. Suhas Raut published two research papers in the UGC recognized journals. He also contributed for writing a unit of Additional English at B.A. Past-I and wrote a SIM unit at B.A. Past-III level special English. The CHB members of faculty, Miss Shilpa Kamble, Miss Savita Kamble published their research papers. All the members completed their teaching duties online and offline mode, conducted seminars and practise tests on the prescribed syllabus</p> <p>ii) Department of Marathi published wallpapers, conducted seminars and tests and taught in online and offline mode. Mrs. Nanda Mole cleared the SET examination.</p>

iii) Department of Hindi conducted online and offline teaching classes. The members of faculty attended the workshops on 'Revised syllabus' and participated in online National Seminars. They conducted seminars, online tests for the students. The HoD, Mrs. Savita Patil received Ph.D. degree from Shivaji University and she published one research paper in 'BHASTMA' a periodical published by Kendriya Hindi Nideshalaya Patika, UGC approved peer-reviewed journal.

iv) Department of Sociology conducted online and offline teaching to all classes. Besides it conducted home assignments, seminars and attended workshops on revised syllabus.

v) Department of History: The members of faculty Dr. Laxmi Bhasale and Mr. Jotiram Adsul conducted online and offline classes, seminars, tests and attended workshops on revised syllabus.
