
## Report of Internal Evaluation & Outcome Records, 2020-21

## Students Satisfaction Survey Report (2020-2021)

The students are one of the stakeholders of the institution. In order to obtain their feedback regarding overall functioning of the college, we designed questionnaire of 17 questions. The survey was conducted in the month of August, 2021.

Out of the total numbers of enrolled student's i. e. 790 during 2020-2021, 233 students responded. It means that 29% students responded. The response was elicited on four Points Scale stating with D to A. The responses were analyzed and forever that Scale 'A' got 53.58%, Scale 'B' got 38.21%, Scale 'C' 4.42% and Scale 'D' zero. Total rating comes to 96.20% out of Scale A & D. The average/mean of the mean is 32.06%. The questionnaire format is enclosed herewith.

The survey questions include the parameters such as physical facilities, syllabus, redressal of grievances, ICC, course outcomes, exam, extracurricular and co-curricular activities, sports and cultural activities. From the responses given by students, it becomes clear that the students are extremely satisfied with the overall performance of the college.

In question no 17, the students were asked to give their suggestions for the improvement of the overall working of the college. These suggestions were put before the IQAC meeting and it was decided to take action regarding the suggestions made by students.

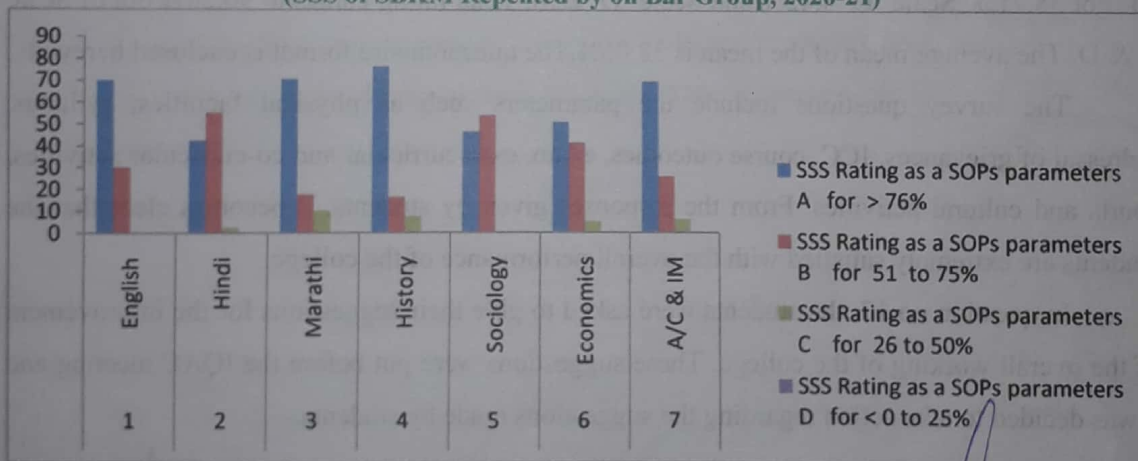


